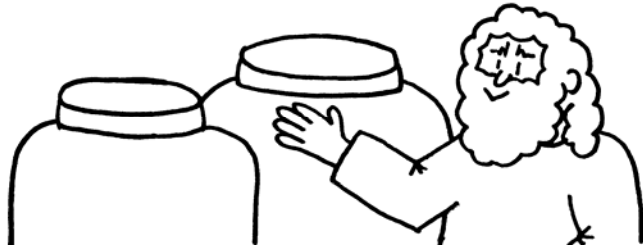

Mark 10:46-52

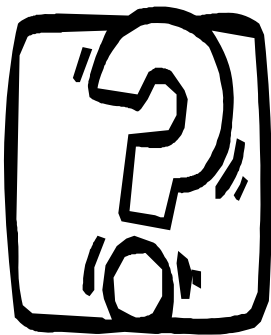


Weekly Scripture:

Mark 10:52 (ICB)

- Bartimaeus' story is a wonderful picture of us before and after we meet Jesus. Explore this with your child to find the similarities and differences. You may even wish to share your own conversion story. If your child has made a decision to follow Jesus like Bartimaeus did, let him practice sharing his testimony with you.
