Weekly Scripture: *Rejoice, people of Jerusalem. Shout for joy, people of Jerusalem. Your king is coming to you. He does what is right, and he saves. He is gentle and riding on a donkey. He is on the colt of a donkey.*

Zechariah 9:9 (ICB)

- ◆ Consider together how Jesus is our king. How can we treat Jesus like a king?

Weekly Scriptures: *I passed on to you what I received. And this was the most important: that Christ died for our sins, as the Scriptures say; that he was buried and was raised to life on the third day as the Scriptures say; and that he showed himself to Peter and then to the twelve apostles.*

I Corinthians 15:3-5 (ICB)

*This is how we know what real love is: Jesus gave his life for us.*

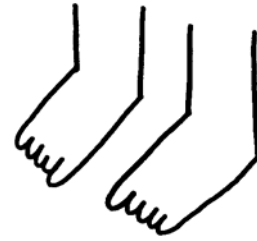
I John 3:16 (ICB)

~ Jesus Appears On The Road To Emmaus

Luke 24:13-32



*Weekly Scriptures: Later Jesus showed himself to two of his followers while they were walking in the country. But Jesus did not look the same as before. These followers went back to the others and told them what had happened. Again, the followers did not believe them.*

Mark 16:12-13 (ICB)

- ◆ Help your child imagine how far seven miles is. Quite a distance to travel to tell the disciples the exciting news! What kind of news would they be willing to walk seven miles to share?

~ Thomas Sees Jesus For Himself

John 20:19-29



*Weekly Scriptures: Then Jesus told him, "You believe because you see me. Those who believe without seeing me will be truly happy."*

John 20:29 (ICB)

*You have not seen Christ, but still you love him. You cannot see him now, but you believe in him. You are filled with a joy that cannot be explained. And that joy is full of glory.*

I Peter 1:8 (ICB)

- ◆ Talk about why Thomas is often called "Doubting Thomas." What did Jesus say would happen if we believed without the kind of proof Thomas had?

~ Jesus Has Breakfast With His Friends

John 21:1-14



*Weekly Scripture: But he was not seen by all people. Only the witnesses that God had already chosen saw him, and we are those witnesses. We ate and drank with him after he was raised from death.*

Acts 10:41 (ICB)

Enjoy a picnic breakfast with your child. Talk about how Jesus' friends knew He was alive!
