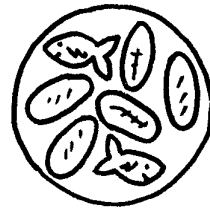

Weekly Scripture: *I want you to share your food with hungry people.*



Isaiah 58:7a (ICB)

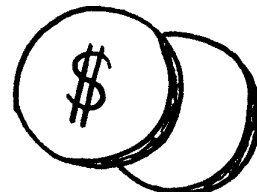
- Help your child to realize that there are people who need food right around you. Jesus cared about people's physical needs and we should too. Talk with your child about what you can do to help meet some of these needs.

March 14, 2010

~ A Woman Shares All

Mark 12:41-44 / Luke 21:1-4

Weekly Scripture: *Each one should give, then, what he has decided in his heart to give. He should not give if it makes him sad. And he should not give if he thinks he is forced to give. God loves the person who gives happily.*



II Corinthians 9:7 (ICB)

- Talk with your child about tithes and offerings and how this principle has impacted your own life. Help him to see the difference between the two. What made the widow's offering so special?

March 21, 2010

~ Mary Shares with Jesus

John 12:1-8

Weekly Scripture: *Jesus answered, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul and mind."*



Matthew 22:37 (ICB)

- Discuss with your child what it means to love God with your heart, soul and mind. How did Mary do this? How can we?

March 28, 2010

~ Peter & John Share the Good News

Acts 3:1-4:4

Weekly Scripture: *The followers went everywhere in the world and told the Good News to people. And the Lord helped them. The Lord proved that the Good News they told was true by giving them power to work miracles.*



Mark 16:20 (ICB)

- Help your child to see that the most valuable thing they can share with others is the Good News. Encourage your child to invite a friend to go to church with her. Consider together some other ways of sharing the Good News with those around you.



A Note to Parents: This month we will be exploring Biblical examples of sharing. It is often difficult to share as adults so we can expect it to be a challenge for children as well. Keep this in mind and look for opportunities to point out times when your child has shared successfully. While there are many things that we can share, the most important thing we have to share with others is the **Good News!**
