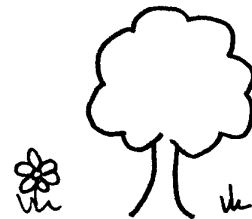
~ God Made the Land, Seas and Plants (Day 3)

Psalms 104:5-9, & 14 (ICB)

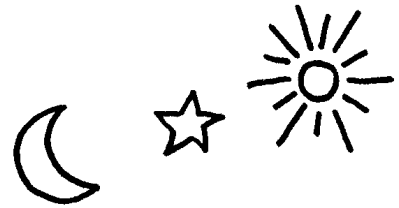
- ◆ Enjoy time at the beach or include your child in a gardening project to enjoy some of God's creation.

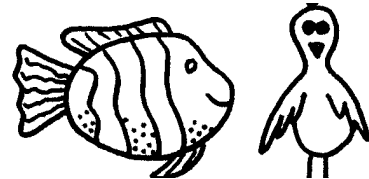
Psalm 136:7-9 (ICB)

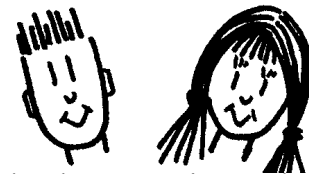
Psalm 104:24-25 (ICB)

- ◆ Talk about how God created us in His image. What does this mean?
