Genesis 24

Weekly Scripture:

~ Naaman Is Thankful


II Kings 5:1-19

Weekly Scripture:

I will give an offering to show thanks to you. And I will worship the Lord.

Psalm 116:17 (ICB)

- Naaman promised to offer sacrifices to no other gods but the Lord to demonstrate his thankfulness. Talk about how we behave can be an offering of thanks to God. See Hebrews 13:14-16.



November 15, 2020

~ Daniel Is Thankful

Daniel 1:17-2:23

Weekly Scripture:

"I thank you and praise you, God of my ancestors. You have given me wisdom and power. You told me what we asked of you. You told us about the king's dream."

Daniel 2:23 (ICB)

- Daniel realized that his ability to understand and tell the king the meaning of his dream came from God. On his own he could not have done it and so he thanked God for His help. Share something with your child that you could not have done on your own and how God helped you. How did you let God know you were thankful?

November 22, 2020

~ Zechariah Is Thankful

Luke 1:5-25. 57-80

Weekly Scriptures:

But God has listened. He has heard my prayer. Praise God. He did not ignore my prayer. He did not hold back his love from me.

Psalms 66: 19-20 (ICB)

I will thank the Lord very much. I will praise him in front of many people.

Psalms 109:30 (ICB)

- Spend a meal, or a day or an evening without talking just like Zechariah had to do until John was born. Afterwards, talk about what that time must have been like for Zechariah. Do you think he was thankful just for his new son?



A Note to Parents: Being thankful is much more than saying a quick thanks - especially when it comes to expressing thanks to God. It is recognizing that what God has done for you occurred only because of Him and nothing that you did. Make a conscious effort this month to focus on the things that you and your child have to be thankful for.
