Genesis 9:16 (ICB)


- Purchase some wide rainbow ribbon. Cut and make it into bookmarks that your child can use to mark special promises in her Bible.

Weekly Scriptures:


A person who gives to others will get richer. Whoever helps others will himself be helped.
